

Bible Quiz # 53 The Book of Judges (Chapters 11-15)

- How does Jephthah try to resolve the conflict with the Ammonites at first? - **He sends messengers to reason with the king of Ammon, attempting a peaceful diplomatic solution**
- What vow does Jephthah make to the Lord? - **He vows that if God grants victory, he will offer as a burnt offering *whatever comes out of his house to meet him when he returns.***
- How long did Jephthah judge Israel? - **Six years.**
- What was unique about Samson's birth? - **His mother was barren until an angel of the Lord announced she would bear a special child.**
- What does it mean that Samson was a Nazirite from birth? - **He was set apart to God, and three restrictions applied: 1. No cutting his hair. 2. No drinking wine of strong drink. 3. No touching anything unclean.**
- What is the significance of the angel ascending in the flame of the altar? - **It revealed that the messenger was no ordinary man but a divine being, leading Manoah to fear they had seen God.**
- What does it mean that Samson's desire was "from the Lord"? - **God intended to use the situation to create conflict with the Philistines and begin Israel's deliverance.**
- How does Samson kill the lion? - **The Spirit of the Lord rushed upon him and he tore the lion apart with his bare hands.**
- Samson destroyed the Philistines' crops by using: - **A torch in foxes' tails**
- Samson was allowed to cut his hair because he was a Nazirite only temporarily. - **False—He was a Nazirite from birth.**

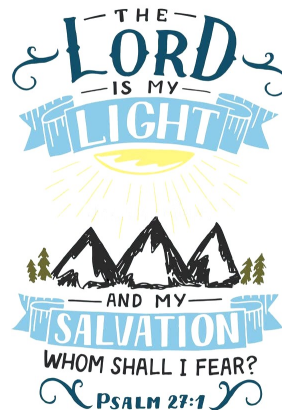

St. Teresa of Calcutta told a beautiful story of a man who was brought out of darkness into the light. One day, in Melbourne, Australia, she visited a poor man whom nobody knew existed. The room in which he lived was terribly unclean. The doors and windows were never opened to let in the light. She began cleaning the room. At first, the man protested, saying, “Leave it alone. It’s all right as it is.” But she continued cleaning anyway.

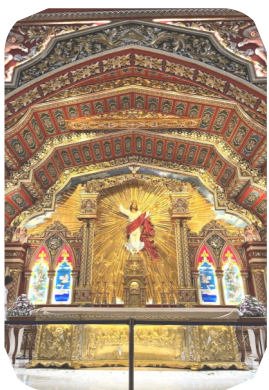
Under a pile of rubbish, she found a beautiful oil lamp covered with dirt. She cleaned and polished it, then asked him, “How come you never light the lamp?” “Why should I light it?” he replied. “No one ever comes to see me.” “Will you promise to light it if one of my sisters comes to visit you?” she asked. “Yes,” he replied. “If I hear a human voice, I’ll light the lamp.” Two of Mother Teresa’s nuns began to visit him regularly. Gradually, things improved. Then one day he said to the nuns, “Sisters, I’ll be able to manage on my own from now on, but please do me a favor: tell that first sister who came to see me that the light she lit in my life is still burning.”

God is light, and He dispels all darkness. He invites us to live enlightened lives, bringing light into the darkened lives of others. The liturgical readings call us to know and accept Jesus as the light for our journey.

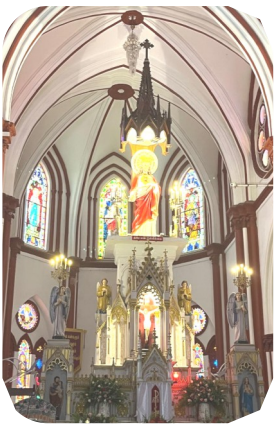

St. George Basilica
Kochi, Kerala

St. George’s Forane Church is a Catholic pilgrimage church in Edapally, Kochi, India. Being Asia’s largest shrine to Saint George, about five million people visit it every year. The church is believed to have been founded in 593 AD. It is regarded as one of the oldest churches in Kerala, after the seven churches founded by Thomas the Apostle in the first century AD.
