5 THINGS EVERY CHRISTIAN SHOULD KNOW ABOUT THE HOLY SPIRIT

1. THE HOLY SPIRIT IS A PERSON.

The Holy Spirit is the third Person of the Holy Trinity.



2. THE HOLY SPIRIT IS FULLY GOD.

All three persons of the Holy Trinity are fully God and "equal in glory." As a divine person, Catholics believe the Holy Spirit possesses the same nature and essence as the Father and the Son, sharing in their divinity.

3. THE HOLY SPIRIT HAS ALWAYS EXISTED.

God eternally exists as the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

4. YOU RECEIVE THE HOLY SPIRIT AT BAPTISM AND CONFIRMATION.

We first receive the Holy Spirit in Baptism. Then, the Sacrament of Confirmation strengthens in us the gift of the Holy Spirit. This indwelling presence helps believers grow in holiness, conforming them more closely to the image of Christ.

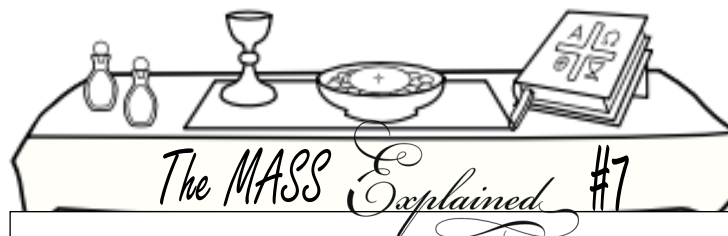

The Liturgy of the Eucharist

The Liturgy of the Eucharist is the high point of Mass. It corresponds to the words and actions of Jesus at the Last Supper where he is finally and uniquely made present to us in the Mass through bread and wine that is transubstantiated into his body and blood. The complete change of the substance of bread and wine into the substance of Christ's body and blood by a validly ordained priest during the consecration at Mass is complete, so that only the accidents of bread and wine remain.

- Preparation of the Altar and Presentation of the Gifts:

As our priest begins to prepare the altar, representatives of the people bring forward the bread and wine along with monetary gifts for the support of the Church and care of the poor. An offertory song may be sung at this time.

- Prayer Over the Gifts:

Helping those assembled to get ready for the tremendous Sacrifice of the Body and Blood of Christ, the priest praises God and prays a blessing prayer offering the bread and wine to God. He then washes his hands as a symbolic gesture of purification.

- Invitation to Prayer:

The priest invites the faithful to pray "that my sacrifice and yours may be acceptable to God, the almighty Father." The faithful prayerfully respond, "May the Lord accept the sacrifice at your hands for the praise and glory of his name, for our good and the good of all his holy Church."

TREASURE WITHIN



An old beggar lay on his deathbed. His last words were to his young son who had been his constant companion during his begging trips. "Dear son," he said, "I have nothing to give you except a cotton bag and a dirty bronze bowl which I got in my younger days from the junk yard of a rich lady." After his father's death, the boy continued begging, using the bowl his father had given him. One day a gold merchant dropped a coin in the boy's bowl and he was surprised to hear a familiar ring. "Let me check your bowl," the merchant said. To his great surprise, he found that the beggar's bowl was made of pure gold. "My dear young man," he said, "why do you waste your time begging? You are a rich man. That bowl of yours is worth at least \$30,000.00."

We Christians are often like this beggar boy who failed to recognize and appreciate the value of his bowl. We fail to appreciate the infinite worth of the Holy Spirit living within us, making each of us His Temple and sharing His gifts, fruits, and charisms with us.



How beautiful is the thought that the Holy Spirit lives within us! Saint Paul reminds the Corinthian community of this fact when he asks, "Do you not know that you are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in you?" (1 Cor 3:16). It is the Holy Spirit who develops our intimacy with God. "God's love has been poured into our hearts by the Holy Spirit who has been given to us" (Rom 5:5). "No one can say, 'Jesus is Lord,' except by the Holy Spirit" (1 Cor 12:3). Moreover, we know that it is the Holy Spirit



who teaches us to pray (Rom 8:26). By the power of the Spirit, we also know the Lord Jesus through His Church.



Pentecost Sunday is the birthday of the Church, for it was the coming of the Holy Spirit upon the apostles and Mary that brought the Church into full active life on earth, and it is the Holy Spirit who still enlivens, enlightens, guides, and sanctifies the Church. The Holy Spirit will continue to do these things and more until the end of the world.

There was once an Eskimo who used to take his two dogs for a bet-fight in the town square. One was a black dog the other was white. The people gathered week after week to see the dogs fight and bet heavily on the outcome. On some days, the black dog won, and on others the white prevailed. No matter which dog won, the Eskimo made money. The secret behind his duping of the people was that he would feed well the dog which he wanted to win. Do you feed your spiritual self and keep it strengthened by the daily



anointing of the Holy Spirit to win over the carnal person?

On this major feast day, we are invited to experience and appreciate the transforming, sanctifying, and strengthening presence of the Holy Spirit within us. This is also a day for us to renew our promises made to God during our Baptism and Confirmation, to profess our Faith, and to practice it.

1. He prays with us - "...comes to the aid of my weakness..." Romans 8:26

It is comforting to know that when we pray, we are not alone. The Comforter whom Jesus sent helps us. It is like having Jesus sitting with us when praying. The Holy Spirit is literally our prayer partner..

2. He prays for us - "...intercedes..." Romans 8:26.

Because the Holy Spirit is our prayer partner, He doesn't just join us in prayer. The Spirit prays for us. He prays for us on our behalf before God. The Spirit knows we need help praying.

3. He interprets what we are feeling - "...with inexpressible groanings..." Romans 8:26.

We need help praying because we have emotions that can get in the way. There are many times when we are

praying and words don't completely express what we are feeling. We have these emotions and the Spirit knows these emotions.

4. He looks for our feelings - "...searches hearts..." Romans 8:27.

The fact of the matter is that we can't search our feelings very well. The Holy Spirit cuts through the cloud of confusion and searches our feelings and hearts to know what we really want to pray for.

5. He helps us to really pray - "...according to God's will." Romans 8:27.

We don't always pray for God's will. And even when we do, we don't always do that very well. The Holy Spirit helps to align our will with God's will in prayer.
